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### Abstract

The sample was randomly selected from Aurangabad district. The total no of student boys 30 and girls 30. The Boys mean 54.27 and girls mean 59.33. The t value of social anxiety among Adolescent is 2.647. The df was 58 at 0.05 level table value is 2.00 and at 0.01 level table value was 2.66. Our obtained t value was 2.647. So it was statistically significant at the level of 0.05. The results indicated that there was significant difference in the study of social anxiety among adolescents. Researcher found more social anxiety in BHMS first year Muslim girls than in boys.*
