

Anxiety Level and Job Satisfaction among Teachers of Secondary School

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Abstract

The purpose of this study was to find out anxiety level and job satisfaction among teachers of secondary school of Ahmadabad city, Gujarat. A sample of 120 teachers, which were 60 from government and 60 from private secondary school teachers and 60 male and female randomly selected. The obtained data were analyzed using mean, SD, 't' test and correlation 'r'. The job satisfaction scale developed by Dr. Amar Singh & Dr. T.R. Sharma and comprehension anxiety test developed by A.K.P. Sinha & L.N.K Sinha were used. The result shows that there is no significant difference found between secondary school teachers in different type of school (government and private) and gender in relation to their anxiety level and job satisfaction. And there is a negative co-relation between anxiety and job satisfaction of govt. and private secondary school teachers.
